School Supplies 2022 / 2023

A reminder that for the 2022 / 2023 school year, we are buying school supplies for students through the school. *Please note that you will not need to pick up supplies from the school. Your child's teacher will provide them with supplies they need when they come to school.* We are encouraging families to order through the school as this allows teachers to order what is needed for their class, reduce extra or left-over supplies, and provide consistency in each class. All funds will be used to pay for students' school supplies.

In June, we asked families to pay \$30 for each child to cover the cost of the supplies that families would usually send their children to school with if they were able to.

If you did not have the chance to purchase supplies before the end of the year, the link to purchase school supplies for the school is open again. You can visit the school website and click the link "school cash online payments". You will be prompted to either sign in or register.

Greater Victoria School District Elementary Schedule Update (recess and lunch times)

The District would like to thank the school staff members and educational community for engaging in many thoughtful conversations about elementary school schedules. There was much planning and consultation that accompanied decisions made for the 2022-2023 school year, especially about eat and play times during the day. Just recently the district has received a legal Arbitration ruling specifically about learning lunch. On a go-forward basis beginning in September, elementary students will have a 45 minute break mid-day to eat and play; this break will separate the morning and afternoon instructional times. Instructional minutes and eating time will no longer be combined. As always, the District will continue to engage the community each year to evaluate and assess the schedule to determine best practices for students.

What students should bring to school

Lunch and snack

- Refillable water bottles
- Containers and packages that students can open independently
- Reusable containers are encouraged. Students will be asked to take home any remaining food and garbage from their snacks and lunches.
- Students are to bring food and snacks that are nut and allergen free. Information will be sent home if there are any allergies in your child's class to be aware of. We ask that student do not bring food to share

Clothing

Students need to be prepared with clothing that allows be outside and to be active. Students will be outside at recess time most days. Please make sure your child has west coast appropriate coats and footwear when the weather gets colder. It is a good idea to have a change of clothes at school.

School Supplies

• Teachers have ordered the school supplies needed for your child. You do not need to send these to school.
