## School Supplies 2023 / 2024

For the 2023 / 2024 school year, we are buying school supplies for students through the school as we did last year. *Please note that you will not need to pick up supplies from the school if you order through us.* Your child's teacher will provide them with supplies needed in September. We ask that if you can, please pay \$40 for each child to cover the cost of the supplies that families would usually send their children to school with. If you wish, you are welcome to pay for an additional child to help cover the cost for families who cannot pay. We are encouraging families to order through the school as this allows teachers to order what is needed for their class, reduce extra or left-over supplies, and provide consistency in each class. All funds will be used to pay for students' school supplies.
