# Child Care at École Willows Elementary

Please see the message below from our District Principal, Charmaine Shortt.

Accessing child care can be a stressful process for many families. The Greater Victoria School District recognizes the demand and has a clear mandate for expanding quality child care on school grounds and we are working tirelessly alongside care providers to promote growth in our community.

The Greater Victoria School District prioritizes available school space for Before & After Care. We have a process in place to select child care providers when space is available. This is a transparent and thoughtful process that ensures quality and inclusive child care. All community child care providers are welcome to apply.

In addition to utilizing available space within the school, we are pleased to share that new stand-alone studio units are also being built by the Facilities Department of the Greater Victoria School District. The completed units are then placed on school grounds to create more space and access to child care.

Currently, 25 new child care units for Elementary Schools across the District have been developed. École Willows Elementary will benefit from this ongoing project in the near future. Updates will be shared as new information becomes available.

If you are currently seeking child care, the <u>Child Care Resource and Referral Centre</u> has up to date lists of available child care across Greater Victoria.
